Broome Health Campus

Broome Health Campus serves one of the States leading tourist destinations. The 60 bed hospital provides health care to a resident population of 15,000 which expands to 50,000 during the tourist season. Broome Health Campus is the regional resource center for the Kimberley and resident and specialist medical staff provides health care services to hospitals, community and remote sites across the region. The hospital has undergone an eight-year redevelopment providing North-West residents access to a high quality, modern health service to match the Kimberley region's growing demands. The major upgrade includes new operation theatres, consulting rooms for visiting specialists, a public dental surgery, refurbished maternity unit and an expanded \$10.4 million Emergency Department which has more than doubled to 15 acute bays. The campus is also now equipped with the latest specialist equipment and provides a modern and purpose-built environment for patients to receive high quality care. Broome Health Campus provides specialist care in General Medicine, General Surgery, Paediatrics and Obstetrics/Gynaecology and is supported by other visiting specialists. A new Paediatric Unit and Psychiatric Unit at Broome Health Campus opened in 2012.

The Kimberley is the most northern and tropical region of WA.
