



Registrar / Trainee - Paediatrics

WA Country Health Service (WACHS) Kimberley is seeking two (2) full time Registrars Paediatrics for 12 months (or four [4] Registrars for six [6] months each) commencing work in 2019 Based in Broome

The Role

We are seeking enthusiastic registrars to join our team in the beautiful Kimberley region, based in Broome. We have a busy 8-bed inpatient unit, a level 2 nursery, a fascinating outreach program, regional neonatal transport service and opportunities to engage in service development and research. There is a strong team of consultant paediatricians resident in Broome providing close supervision and support while also giving opportunities for independent practice. Both positions are accredited by the Advanced Training Committee in General Paediatrics of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians as General Paediatrics (Rural) with a Perinatal Component. Six month terms are accredited as 6 months General Paediatrics only. Options for accreditation of a 12 month term are:

- 12 months General Paediatrics
- 6 months General Paediatrics and 6 months Community/Developmental
- 6 months General Paediatrics and 6 months Acute Care



One of the two positions is funded through the Australian Government Specialist Training Program (STP). The successful candidate (s) for the STP-funded position must NOT be eligible for taking out their fellowship during the time the position is held, i.e. they must be in Year 1, 2 or 3 of their advanced training and may complete their advanced training at THE END of their rotation. The successful candidate (s) must not be eligible to take out their fellowship at any time that the position is held. In this position you will be required to participate in the on call roster.

Current Registrars and Senior Registrars are invited to apply. Appointment will be made based on skills and experience.

The Package

Full time (80 hours per fortnight) salary as per WA Health System Medical Practitioners AMA Industrial Agreement 2016:

Registrar Years 1-3 \$152,387 - \$166,976 pa*

*includes base salary \$129,990 - \$143,314 pa, professional development allowance \$10,048 pa and 9.50% employer contributed Superannuation

or

Health Service Medical Practitioner Years 1- 6 \$250,335 - \$315,611 pa*

*includes base salary \$200,641 - \$260,254 pa, professional development allowance \$30,633 pa and 9.50% employer contributed Superannuation
Rates effective as of 1st October 2018.

In addition (in line with operational requirements), access to salary packaging up to \$19,000 pa, professional development opportunities and study leave/assistance may apply. Shift and after hours penalties are additional to this package.

How to Apply

Applicants are advised to provide the following:

- A curriculum vitae summarising your experience and how you are able to meet the position requirements.
- A statement addressing each of the selection criteria (The selection criteria are located in the Job Description Form (JDF)).
- Proof of Citizenship and Residency status (required) e.g. copy of passport and (if applicable) copy of current visa OR Australian birth certificate.
- Required if applicable - Evidence of English language skills registration standard, AMC Certificate, AMC Multiple Choice Questionnaire results

Documents should be complete and ready to attached prior to applying online.

If suitable, applications are accepted to the Registrar Pool and your application will remain on file until the closure of the pool. You may be contacted during this time to determine your interest in future vacancies. If shortlisted for an interview, you will be contacted to arrange a suitable time. In the event you are not shortlisted for the position, you will be notified at the conclusion of the recruitment process.
