## The Role

Albany Health Campus is on the lookout for a Gynaecology Service Registrar for appointment for 6 months.

The person we are looking for will have good attitude, be of high integrity, fluent in English, with excellent clinical and communication skills. Prior exposure and work experience in keeping with that expected from a Registrar in Obstetrics and Gynaecology year 1-2 is required. You must demonstrate excellent rapport with patients and your colleagues and be a team player.

You will be working with a team of two Consultant Obstetricians and Gynaecologists based in Albany health Campus. You will be providing support in Birth Suite to GP Obstetricians and the Consultants, as needed.

Experience and expectations required are:

- Participate in conducting Gynaecology, Colposcopy and Specialist Antenatal outpatient's clinics, while working under the supervision of O&G Consultants.
- Participate in On Call roster with Consultants also being rostered as second on call. You will be expected to be first on call 2-3 times during weekdays, and every alternate weekend. You will not be on call without consultant cover.
- Assist the consultants at Elective and Emergency surgery.
- Participate in review and assessment of O&G patients referred from ED and other Departments
- Undertake ward rounds and reviews of patients admitted under the Consultants (with Consultant supervision).
- Provide a very high standard of care to patients, show empathy and respect
- Have good documentation skills
- Demonstrate good time management skills
- Participate in continuing Professional Development Activities
