How to Apply

Applicants are advised to provide the following:

- A cover letter stating the position and location of interest
eg: Service – General Medicine, Bunbury Health Campus
- A Curriculum vitae summarizing your experience and how you are able to meet the position requirements
- A statement addressing each of the selection criteria (Located in the Job Description Form JDF)
- Proof of Citizenship and Residency status
- Required if applicable – Evidence of English language skills registration standard, AMC certificate, AMC multiple choice questionnaire results.

Documents should be complete and ready to be attached prior to applying online.

The Role

The successful applicants will have a minimum of 6 months experience in General Medicine with a preference for candidates who have experience from Australia or a recognised competent authority country (United Kingdom, Canada, United States, New Zealand and Ireland). Candidates must be eligible for registration with the Medical Board of Australia.

The successful candidates will be responsible for the clinical care of patients under the supervision of senior medical staff including: attending to patients in order of medical urgency; taking history of full medical examinations of new admissions and arranging appropriate investigations and assisting/performing medical procedures as required; managing medical conditions according to high level clinical standards under supervision of consultants; collaborating with other Medical, Nursing staff and multidisciplinary team members to facilitate patient management and communication with family, outside medical practitioners, and/or community services concerning patient management.

The successful applicant will also be required to work with Consultants in the efficient delivery of KPIs, timely discharge summaries and efficient discharge planning. Our unit has 41 beds and will expose you to a very wide range of medical presentations. Bunbury Health Campus is accredited for Basic training with RACP and has an active education program.
