**This is an STP funded position and the applicant must be an Advanced Trainee in Paediatrics.**

### The Package

Full time (80 hours per fortnight) salary as per WA Health System Medical Practitioners AMA Industrial Agreement 2016:

- A statement addressing each of the selection criteria (Located in the Job Description Form JDF)
- Proof of Citizenship and Residency status
- Required if applicable – Evidence of English language skills registration standard, AMC certificate, AMC multiple choice questionnaire results.

### The Role

These 6 month positions are accredited as 6 months Rural Paediatrics by the Specialist Advisory Committee (SAC).

The positions involve:

- Supervision and management of paediatric inpatients including patients on the children's ward and newborns on the maternity unit and in the special care nursery, under the supervision of the Consultant Paediatrician on call.
- Assessment of referrals from the Emergency Department
- Providing Registrar Assessments of Patients at the Rapid Review and Discharge Clinic
- Participation in the departmental teaching program including teaching of junior doctors and medical students
- Working in a multidisciplinary rural/regional paediatric team
- Participation in the on-call roster.

Current Registrars and Senior Registrars are invited to apply.

Appointment will be made based on skills and experience.

The department has a 12-bed general paediatric ward and a busy neonatal service with 6-bed Special Care Nursery. The department has one Head of Department, four part-time Paediatricians, and two Resident Medical Officers.
