One of these positions can be offered to an advanced trainee in adult general medicine if a suitable candidate applies for as we are currently accredited by the RACP for one year advanced training position.



The Package

Full time (80 hours per fortnight) salary as per WA Health System Medical Practitioners AMA Industrial Agreement 2016:

Registrar Year 1-7, \$130,145 to \$174,823 pa*

* includes base salary \$109,678 to \$150,479 pa, professional Development allowance \$10,048 pa and 9.50% employer contributed Superannuation. Rates as at October 2018.

How to Apply

All applications to be lodged via the **2020 Registrar – Service/Trainee – various position, various locations in Country WA** recruitment Pool online at MedJobsWA.

Applicants are advised to provide the following:

- A cover letter stating the position and location of interest **eg: Service – General Medicine, Geraldton Hospital**
- A Curriculum vitae summarizing your experience and how you are able to meet the position requirements
- A statement addressing each of the selection criteria (Located in the Job Description Form JDF)
- Proof of Citizenship and Residency status
- Required if applicable – Evidence of English language skills registration standard, AMC certificate, AMC multiple choice questionnaire results.

Documents should be complete and ready to be attached prior to applying online.

The Role

These five positions will provide a broad level of medical experience for Junior Doctors entering basic physician training or intending to apply to RACP in the future or completing their advanced training in general medicine. Geraldton Hospital has been accredited by the RACP as a Level 1 Teaching Hospital for Basic Physician Training and for one year advanced training in adult general medicine but is not part of official metro BPT/advanced training programs. However, Medical Registrars have the opportunity to have their service time at Geraldton to be accredited toward their BPT/advanced training programs subject to the RACP approval (further information can be obtained from Geraldton hospital's Director of Physician Education Dr M.N. Richi).

Geraldton Hospital has three medical teams, each managed by a consultant, registrar and junior doctors. Teams are responsible for inpatient and outpatient medical care including: High Dependency Unit, Hospital in the Home, Renal Dialysis and Oncology services. In addition, medical teams provide a high level of support to complex surgical and orthopaedic inpatients and other services. Roster commitments are rotational to cover 24/7 medical service.
