

SPOT GPS Tracker – Cheat Sheet

- 1. Press POWER button until it blinks green.
- 2. Press OK button until it blinks green press at start and end of trip, and at two hourly intervals on bitumen.
- 3. When driving on dirt roads, press FOOTPRINT button until it blinks green.
- 4. Press HELP or SOS for assistance to be sent to that GPS location follow up with phone call if possible.

Tips:

- Place SPOT on sun visor or dashboard facing you so you can see the lights and can reach the device from your seat if necessary.
- Press OK button 2-3 km before your destination to allow time for message cycle to complete - check confirmation as per note below.
- Lights: To activate or de-activate a function, press and hold button for 2-3 seconds until light starts/stops blinking. Note: Using sharp objects such as pens will damage the buttons.
- Messages Sent Confirmation: When SPOT has GPS location and OK message is sent, both GPS and MESSAGE lights will blink green for 15 seconds, MESSAGE will continue to blink green for another hour.
- Priorities: Activating FOOTPRINT (Track Progress button), HELP or SOS will disable unsent OK messages and will send automatic timed messages.

A copy of the WACHS SPOT Tracker Reference Guide is in the vehicle glovebox if additional user information is required.

If SPOT is unable to determine a GPS location after 4 minutes, it will send a message without the GPS location - the GPS light will blink red and the MESSAGE light will blink green together for approximately 15 seconds when the message is sent. SPOT will continue to send messages every 5 minutes for an hour, and continue to seek GPS location for up to 4 minutes.

To cancel, press and hold until the HELP light blinks red - leave SPOT on until HELP stops blinking red - the MESSAGE light will blink green indicating it has sent the Cancel message.

** **SOS**

SPOT will send a message within one minute after activation, with or without a GPS location - the GPS light will blink red and the MESSAGE light will blink green together for approximately 15 seconds when the message is sent. SPOT will continue to send messages every 5 minutes until cancelled or batteries fail, and continue to seek GPS location for up to 4 minutes for all subsequent messages.

To cancel, press and hold until the SOS light blinks red - leave SPOT on until SOS stops blinking red - the MESSAGE light will blink green indicating it has sent the Cancel message.
