



# Australian Resuscitation Council - Advanced Life Support 2

## Geraldton, 8 - 9 June 2022

This two-day Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) course aims to teach senior members of the multi-disciplinary team the theory and practical skills to effectively manage cardio-respiratory arrest, peri-arrest situations and cardiac arrests in special circumstances.

### Course Content:

- Causes and prevention of cardiac arrest
- Advanced Life Support (ALS) treatment algorithm
- Post resuscitation care

### Workshops

- Advanced airway management
- Systemic patient assessment (A-E approach)
- Manual or Automatic defibrillation
- Cardiac arrest simulations

Candidates who successfully complete the program receive an ARC ALS2 Provider certificate, valid for 4 years.

**Eligibility:** For Medical Emergency Team members, medical and nursing staff working in critical care areas, after hours and/or remote sites.

**Cost:** \$300 for WACHS employees  
\$600 for other Health Service employees  
\$1500 for external candidates
