The Psychiatric Emergencies Assessment and Care (PEACE) Workshop is an interactive 1 day program facilitated by a team of emergency medicine and mental health clinicians, designed for medical practitioners and nurses, who practise in rural and remote settings and are looking to refresh their expertise in mental health diagnosis and treatment.

This program equips participants with the skills required to manage patients with chronic mental health conditions who present to the emergency department in crisis.


The workshop objectives include:

- Mental health assessment and management
- Prescribing and medication complications in mental health patients
- Review of legal aspects of emergency psychiatry
- Increased understanding of crisis intervention and & brief therapies
- Understanding of medications, alcohol, and drug dependence
