

VAST Facilitator Course

VAST is a not-for-profit organisation offering programs aimed at overcoming the barriers to widespread delivery of simulation-based education. The VAST Facilitator Course is designed to be adaptable and flexible, accommodating participants of varied clinical backgrounds. No prior simulation experience is required. It is aimed at those involved or interested in healthcare education who want to explore using simulation training in their setting.

The course will equip participants with a robust simulation 'toolkit', beginning the journey towards design and delivery of high-quality simulation and debriefing.
