



NHET Sim Workshop C2 Being a Simulation Educator – 1 Day Course Broome – 7 November 2024

The National Health Education and Training in Simulation (NHET-Sim) program is a nationwide training program for healthcare professionals and their educators aimed at improving clinical training capacity.

This core module covers basic principles of simulation with a focus on educational design for simulation scenarios, briefing and debriefing practices. We consider what it means to be a simulation educator.

By attending the workshop, this module facilitates formation of a local community of practice by bringing participants together to discuss and practice Simulation Based Education (SBE) and training techniques. Participants have access to the NHET Sim e-learning materials to support the workshop
