



Practical Obstetric Multi-Professional Training (PROMPT) Margaret River, 19 September 2024

The PROMPT Global program is an evidence-based obstetric emergencies training package, developed by the PROMPT Maternity Foundation UK for international, multi-professional teams and clinicians required to respond to obstetric emergencies. The program aims to reduce preventable harm for mothers and their babies and is achieved by training staff in their local, real-time working clinical environment.

The PROMPT Global package improves teamwork and consists of interactive lectures, drills and workshops, providing hands-on experience of practical skills through simulated obstetric emergency situations. The key component being the multi-professional and locally delivered approach, incorporating the whole team in their usual response roles.

Eligibility: All Maternity Care practitioners working in a maternity hospital – Midwives, Obstetricians, GPAs, GPOs and those who are required to respond to maternity emergencies including ward nurses, after hours managers and theatre staff. Obstetric Emergency Training is required every three years for GP's/Obstetricians and Midwifes.
