Resident Medical Officers (RMOs)

RMO contracts are offered at several locations and may include rotations at other sites within the region.

Vocational training pathways

Opportunities to participate in vocational training pathways at WACHS include the Rural Generalist Pathway WA, Rural Psychiatry Training WA, WA Intensive Care Training Pathway and the Rural Physician Training Pathway WA.

Applying for a WA Country Health Service internship

Applications for intern positions must be submitted through **MedCareersWA** via the Postgraduate Medical Council of WA Centralised Recruitment Process. Applicants should select WA Country Health Service (WACHS) as their Primary Employing Health Service (PEHS) and then rank their preferred internship locations.

In your application, clearly state your interest and suitability for a rural position, as well as your reasons for choosing your preferred sites. Selection and appointment is based on merit.

Successful applicants will receive a three year contract with the ability to change WACHS location or PEHS at the completion of internship.

Complete rural terms with WA Country Health Service

Intern and RMO rural rotations are available for one or more terms. Location and availability are dependent on the employing health service. Further details can be found in the table below:
