The Midwest region sits in the western middle section of WA. It is bordered by the Indian Ocean in the west, the Pilbara region in the north, the Wheatbelt to the south and the Goldfields in the southeast.


Living and working in the region

The Midwest region covers four health districts – Gascoyne, Geraldton, Midwest and Murchison with one regional centre in Geraldton and a smaller northern district centre located in Carnarvon.

Geraldton Health Campus

The hospital has 60 beds for acute medical, surgical, paediatric and maternity patients with a 24-hour Emergency Department and onsite chemotherapy and renal dialysis. It provides a comprehensive range of patient care services including medical imaging and pathology.

Geraldton Health Campus supports a range of accredited intern and Resident Medical Officer (RMO) rotations which provide the required experience, education and support for prevocational doctors who wish to gain rural experience. Geraldton has college accredited registrar training positions and offers the Australian Medical Council (AMC) accredited Workplace Based Assessment (WBA) program.

Applying to WA Country Health Service

Intern applicants have the option to complete their internship in Geraldton by selecting WA Country Health Service (WACHS) as their Primary Employing Health Service (PEHS) via the WA Centralised Intern Recruitment Process. Applicants will be prompted to rank their preferred internship locations. Successful applicants receive a three year contract with the ability to change WACHS location or PEHS at the completion of internship.

WA Country Health Service is a direct employer of RMOs at Geraldton Health Camppus through the Centralised Recruitment Process.

Applications for intern and RMO positions must be submitted via **MedCareersWA** through the Centralised Recruitment Process. In your application, clearly state your interest and suitability for a rural position. Selection and appointment will be based on merit.

Rotational opportunties

Intern applicants can express interest for rural rotations via their PEHS' term allocation process. Intern rotations to Geraldton Health Campus are available from Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital.

Note: Allocation to rural terms is determined by the employing hospital's term allocation process.

Geraldton RMO rotations are available via the Rural Community Residency Program (CRP).

Geraldton medical education and support

The Medical Education program at Geraldton Health Campus is developed and led by the regional Director of Clinical Training (DCT) and coordinated by the Medical Education Officers (MEOs).
