Kalgoorlie Health Campus is accredited by the Australian Medical Council (AMC) to provide the Workplace Based Assessment (WBA) Program. The WBA is an alternative to the AMC clinical examination for International Medical Graduates using the AMC Standard Pathway to achieve eligibility for general registration with the Medical Board of Australia.

To apply for a Workplace Based Assessment program opportunity you must first be successful and appointed to a junior doctor position with WA Country Health Service.

#### The role

Resident Medical Officers (RMOs) working at Kalgoorlie Health Campus will rotate through Emergency, General Medicine, Obstetrics and Gynaecology and Mental Health Departments and General Surgery and High Dependency Unit (successful IMG applicant will be invited to apply for the WBA program if required).

You will provide a high quality clinical service to all hospital patients under the supervision of clinical supervisors including registrars, consultants and other senior staff within a multidisciplinary team. You will also work within your ability and according to the hospital's core values and will be able to expand your knowledge and skills through the available learning opportunities.

Kalgoorlie Health Campus is a 100-bed inpatient facility and one of the largest regional public hospitals in WA.



The hospital supports medical students through the Rural Clinical School, junior doctors rotating from Perth, Workplace Based Assessment doctors and registrars across a number of specialties.

Kalgoorlie is Australia's largest outback city, and the heart of WA's Goldfields region - Australia's gold capital. The area is more than three times the size of Victoria and covers almost a third of WA's total land mass.

As one of the largest regions in WA, its diverse natural environments range from sprawling deserts in the north and east to pristine white beaches and emerald seas in the South. With a population of more than 30,000, the area is a dynamic and sophisticated regional centre and has many chain stores and services. Sport facilities, clubs and societies and social services abound to support a good work life balance.
