Geraldton Health Campus is accredited by the Australian Medical Council (AMC) to administer the Workplace Based Assessment (WBA) Program. The WBA is an alternative to the AMC clinical examination for International Medical Graduates (IMG) using the AMC Standard Pathway to achieve eligibility for general registration with the Medical Board of Australia.

**To apply for a WBA program, you must first be successfully appointed to a junior doctor position with WA Country Health Service.**

### The role

You will be supported to provide a high quality of clinical service to all hospital patients under the supervision of clinical supervisors including registrars, consultants and other senior staff within a multidisciplinary team. You are expected to work within your ability and according to the core values of the organisation and will be supported in expanding your knowledge and skills through the available learning opportunities.



## Experience life in the region

**Geraldton is located 425km north of Perth and is home to one of the most attractive coastal centres in WA. It offers beachside living alongside rural life as well as a wide range of recreational, shopping and educational facilities.**

Geraldton is part of WA's Coral Coast and is world renowned for an extensive host of water sports including spectacular kitesurfing, windsurfing, fishing and diving. The Abrolhos Islands are 70km offshore and have many fantastic diving and snorkelling locations. Nearby National Parks are great for hiking and camping. Geraldton has an enviable Mediterranean climate and a relaxed seaside lifestyle which lends itself to a host of activities, especially water sports. There are good schools in the residential areas which are located a short drive from the hospital.

Geraldton Health Campus is the major medical resource centre for the Midwest. The Emergency Department (ED) sees approximately 36,000 presentations per year including a large proportion of paediatrics and Aboriginal patients, with high activity and an admission rate of about 22 per cent. A highly varied case-mix will provide many opportunities to gain hands on procedural skills and a broad clinical experience. You will gain expertise in Aboriginal Health, as well as rural and remote practice.

Geraldton Health Campus has 100 hospital beds for acute medical, surgical, paediatric and maternity patients with a 24-hour ED, onsite chemotherapy and renal dialysis. It provides a comprehensive range of patient care service including medical imaging and pathology. Visiting specialists provide varied learning opportunities for junior doctors across a range of specialties.

The hospital has a strong association with the local Aboriginal Medical Service, St John of God Hospital and GP community. There are plans well underway for redevelopment of the emergency department and inpatient services. Midwest profiles are being strengthened across departments, making it an exciting time to join the service.

The hospital offers an excellent supported environment that exposes trainees to a spectrum of disease and practical learning opportunity.

The ED is the local referral centre for patient transfers from surrounding smaller facilities and is often involved in the provision of critical care and stabilisation of patients prior to aeromedical retrieval to tertiary centres.
