Child Development Services	Child Development Services are available for families who have children aged from 0 to 18 years of age to support the development of skills such as eating, hearing, talking understanding, movement, hand skills, and social/play skills. This team consists of Audiologists, Dietitians, Occupational Therapists, Paediatrician, Physiotherapists, Podiatrists, Social Workers, Speech Pathologists, Allied Health Assistants. Referral process: Appointments can be made by phoning Collie Hospital or with the referral form attached on WACHS Child Development Service website. Paediatrician services – referral from GP or Medical Specialist (external) can also be via the Central Referral Service (CRS).
