- The Board reviewed and supported WACHS response to the Sustainable Health Review, interim report.
- Reviewed and endorsed the clinical governance framework.
- The Board was briefed on and supported an interim strategy to improve the process for transferring country mental health patients to metropolitan emergency departments and inpatient sites.

### Key Matters for Discussion

- The Chief Executive's report provided an update on monthly performance, projections and key developments within WACHS over the past month;
- The Board was briefed and discussed the status and risks associated with potential delays in obtaining a replacement to the current Medical Accounts Assessment System used to process visiting medical practitioner claims.
